Fusion Designs is a leader in solid wood case goods made from locally harvested American hardwoods, producing furniture for bedroom, dining room, occasional, entertainment and home office.

Rooted in Amish culture and high-quality construction techniques, Fusion Designs honors its past by individually crafting and hand-finishing its products, while designing for today's lifestyles and aesthetics. Since its founding by Noah Bontrager, the company has built an expansive portfolio of modern and transitional styles, staying ahead of the trend curve by designing both in-house and partnering with world-class furniture designers.

Based in the heartland, Fusion Designs delivers its solid wood, handmade furniture to retailers nationwide, serving some of the largest names in the industry from Top 100 dealers Furniture Row and Living Spaces to smaller independents who look to the family owned and operated company for its customization capabilities and a responsive customer service team that intimately understands their needs.

Led by the second generation and one of the youngest presidents in the industry, Marcus Bontrager heads the in-house design team, inspired by his innate understanding of the needs and desires of a new generation of shoppers. To balance consumers' hunger for personalized looks and innovative features combined with fast shipping, Bontrager eventually shifted to a cellular manufacturing approach that has helped the company shrink lead times and enable quick delivery of bench-built products.

As the story goes, founder Noah Bontrager got his start in the business making furniture as a hobby while working in the RV industry. Over time, he learned the finer points of construction through trial and error and working alongside generations of talented Amish craftspeople in the region. The fresh perspective he brought to his growing business led to the introduction of a number of industry-leading (and much copied) features, including the butterfly table leaf and ball-bearing slides. In fact, to achieve the superior quality he was after, Bontrager has developed and custom-built proprietary manufacturing equipment for the Fusion Designs 80,000-square-foot manufacturing facility that are unique among case goods manufacturers.

Founded in 1995, Fusion Designs specializes in high-quality, American-made solid wood, built-to-order case goods collections for bedroom, dining room, home office and entertainment sold to leading retailers across the U.S. Handcrafted in Indiana from domestically sourced wood species like oak, maple, cherry and hickory available in a choice of 35 finishes, the expansive portfolio of contemporary, transitional and mid-century modern designs is set apart by mortise and tenon construction techniques, upscale features like soft-close drawers and finishes that highlight the natural beauty of the woods, as well as a lifetime warranty.

THE NATURE OF WOOD AND ITS ENVIRONMENT

Hardwood forests cover more than 269 million acres in the United States. Although it takes about 80 years for a tree to mature, natural reseeding and sprouting contribute to the regeneration of our forests. Conscientious caretakers are also responsible for the ongoing rebirth of this country's hardwood resource thanks to the use of a practice known as sustained yield forest management. Thanks to this practice, the United States grows twice as much hardwood as it harvests every year. In fact, current projections show that by the year 2040, the U.S. will have about 70% more hardwoods available for harvest.

Conservation has long been a byword for the wood industry, both in the forest and in manufacturing. Lumber mills use approximately 98% of the entire tree harvested. Thanks to the introduction of laser-guided saws, improved quality control and computer-assisted manufacturing, virtually nothing is wasted. The bark, which can constitute up to 20% of a log, often fuels the mill. Bark also is used to produce mulches and soil conditioners, while trimmings are processed into a variety of wood products, including paper.

Our trees are an ever-renewing gift from nature. A vibrant hardwood forest is a dynamic force, contributing to a clean, healthy environment. Forests cool the atmosphere and filter the water we drink. They convert carbon dioxide into oxygen to give us air to breathe. They provide food and shelter for wildlife and offer a spectacular variety of recreational opportunities. Each Autumn, their green leaves burst into brilliant symphonies of amber, orange, magenta, and thousands of hues in between.

U.S. hardwoods are coveted all over the world for their warmth and lasting beauty in furniture, cabinetry, mill work, and flooring. In finished products, hardwoods are the purest expression of nature. They are not synthetic, nor are they engineered. Their beauty is not just skin deep.

HARDWOODS

Hardwoods include broad-leaved trees like oak, walnut, cherry, maple, hickory, and dozens of other species. Mature hardwoods supply the nation, and much of the world, with timber used for everything from railroad ties to quality furnishings.

Just as each tree is different from the next, so, too, are hardwood products individually unique. Hardwoods are characterized by an infinite variety of grains and distinctive textures. Trees grow limbs that fall off as the tree matures. What remains is a knot on the hardwood surface. These natural markings add character to the wood's appearance and have absolutely no effect on the wood's durability and stability.

At Fusion Designs, we strive to bring out the natural beauty and character of each piece of wood. These characteristics give each piece its unique charm. As a result, even though the finishing processes are identical, no two pieces will ever be exactly the same. Embrace the uniqueness of your hardwood furniture. It's what nature intended.

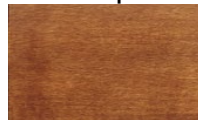
BROWN MAPLE

Brown Maple has a smooth grain pattern and is characterized by the varying brown, tan, white, and cream streaks. It absorbs medium to dark stains well and its smooth surface is ideal for painted finishes.

DURABILITY

It is a softer hardwood so it is more prone to scratches and denting with heavy use. It has a rating of 950 on the Janka Hardness scale*.

One Less Thing to Worry About!

Performance Fabrics are engineered for easy maintenance, comfort, and durability. Performance Fabrics are soft, durable, and stain-resistant. These fabrics are available in a wide array of textures and vibrant colors. Breakthrough protection is woven into every fiber so it won't ever wear away.

Easy Clean:

Performance Fabrics are easy to clean, but are not self-cleaning. Most liquid spills will simply blot off the surface with a dry towel. And for more difficult stains, just follow these simple spot-cleaning instructions:

- Wipe away excess mess using a clean, dry towel
- Mix a simple soap and water solution*
- Apply and agitate with a soft-bristle brush
- Blot with a clean towel
- Rinse thoroughly, repeat if necessary

*We recommend mixing 1 tsp. enzyme laundry detergent, like Tide® or Cheer®, with 2 cups warm water. And remember, soap attracts dirt, so rinse thoroughly.

LEATHERS

Descriptions:

- Premium top-grain glove-soft leather, offers exceptionally soft, silky, hand feel
- Soft silk hard enhanced with the application of a wax touch agent.
- A slightly contrasting crust color is randomly top-sprayed with a translucent solution of highly dispersed micro-pigments to give this leather gentle clouding or smoke effect.
- The natural glow and depth created enhances the sophisticated appearance of this leather.

Thickness:

- 0.9 – 1.0 mm thick

Natural Visibility:

- Some natural marking visible

Finish:

- Top-grain, aniline drum-dyed, micro-pigmented topcoat.
- Moderate protection from application of micro-pigmented topcoat.
- The beauty of aniline drum-dyed leather is the lack of uniformity. The dye does not color all sections of the hide uniformly due to the tissue (or cell) structure.
- The neck may be a bit lighter or darker than the butt; the rib and fat wrinkles may be outlined in a slightly darker cast.

Care & Cleaning:

Vacuum or dust with a soft brush regularly.

For Spots and Spills:

- Gently blot excess liquid with a clean absorbent cloth
- Let air dry naturally

For Butter, Oil, or Grease:

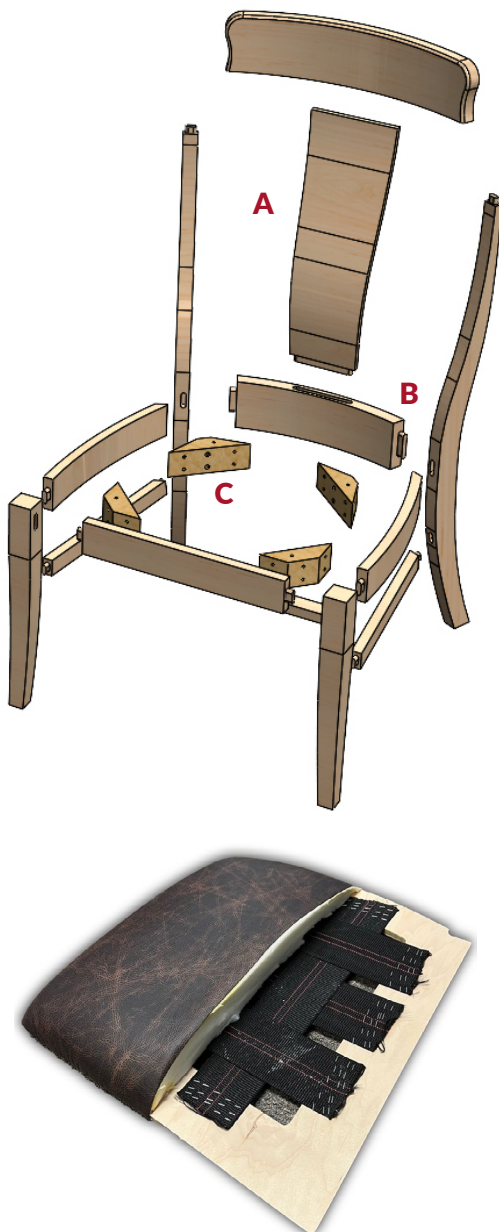
- Absorb excess with a clean, dry cloth
- Leave alone
- Spots should dissipate over a moderate time

Do not apply any shoe polish, ammonia water, oils, or any other chemical solutions.

Recommended: Car and Cleaning kits such as those provided by Leather Master. The natural oils are sealed in for permanent and carefree beauty.

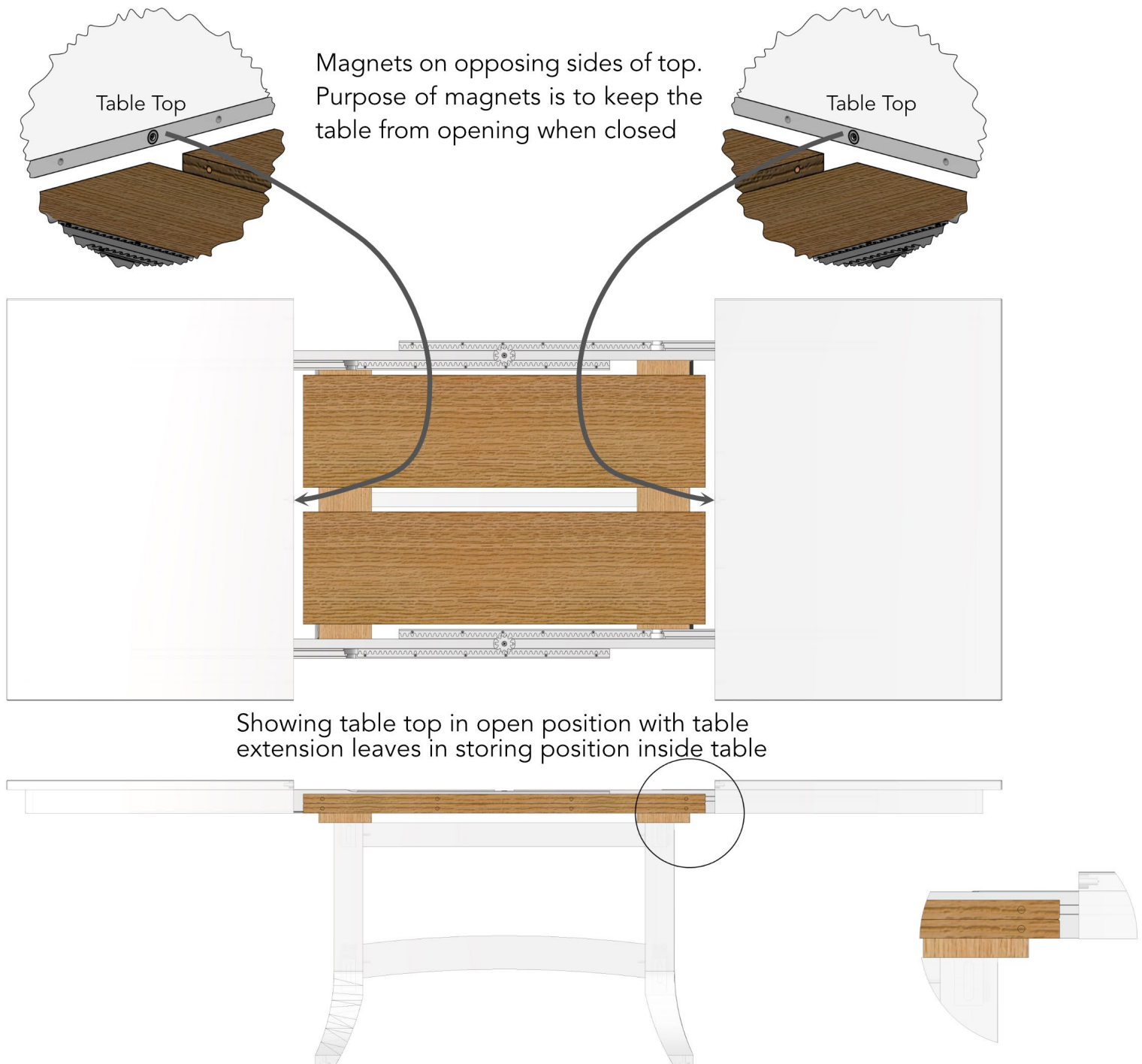

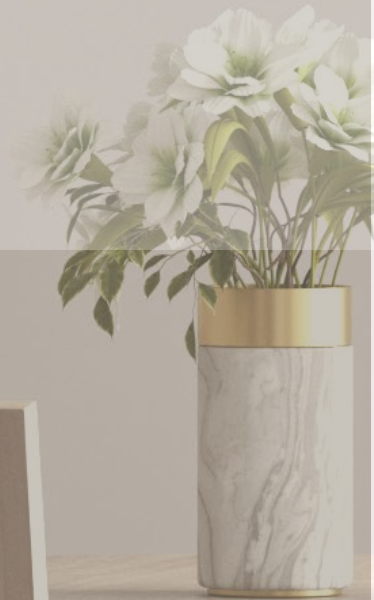

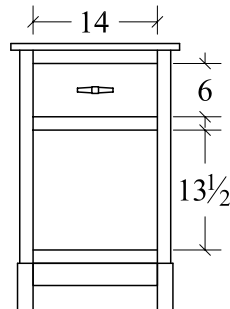

CARING FOR YOUR FUSION DESIGNS FURNITURE

Your new furniture is a reflection of your good taste. It combines nature's best materials with our Amish craftsmanship. To assure that your investment becomes a treasured heirloom to withstand the test of time, take the same care in maintaining the beauty of your furniture as you took in selecting it.



PLACEMENT

Carefully consider where your new furniture is located in your home. Avoid setting it directly in front of radiators, heating vents, or wood-burning stoves as dry air can cause wood to dry out and crack.

HUMIDITY

The ideal indoor humidity range for solid wood furniture is 35-45%. An uncontrolled environment causes expansion and contraction which leads to splitting of the grain pattern or joints and gapping where leaves fit into the table. These conditions should be appreciated as inherent characteristics of solid wood and should not be assumed to be a defect in materials or workmanship.

PROTECTION & CLEAN UP

Simply dust furniture often with a soft cloth taking care to follow the grain pattern. Periodically clean with a mild, non-alkaline soap and water using a soft cloth or sponge. Dry immediately with a soft cloth and lightly buff wood grain. Avoid nail polish remover, alcohol, or other solvents. A high-quality furniture polish may be used occasionally, but do not use polishes that contain silicones. Your retailer can recommend a polish or wax.

LEAF STORAGE

Store extra table leaves in or close to table to maintain consistent environmental conditions (not in a damp basement or dry attic). By following these simple tips, you'll get many years of enjoyment from your new furniture and when you are ready to pass it on, the new owner's first word is sure to be, "Beautiful!"
